and truly to be made, we bind Ourselves, our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, jointly and  
severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our Seals, and dated this the 15 day of January, 1865.

The Condition of the above Obligation is Such, That if the above bounden  
Jessiech Hanson  
Administrator of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits of  
Nancy Hanson, deceased, do make or cause to be made, a true and perfect  
inventory of all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits of the deceased, which have  
or may come to the hands, knowledge or possession of the said Jessiech Hanson,

, or into the hands or possession of  
any person or persons for him, and the same so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited  
in County Court, within the time prescribed by law, after the date of these presents; and the same  
goods, chattels and credits, and all other the goods, chattels and credits of the deceased, at the time  
of his death, or which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said

or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for do well and truly  
administer according to law: And further, do make, or cause to be made, a true and just account  
of his said administration, agreeably to law, after the date of these presents; and all the rest  
and residue of the said goods, chattels and credits, which shall be found remaining upon the said  
administrator

account. (the same being first allowed by Court,) shall deliver and pay unto such person or persons,  
respectively, as the same shall become due, pursuant to the true intent and meaning of the Act in  
that case made and provided—And if it shall appear that any Will or Testament was made by the  
deceased, and the Executor or Executors therein named do exhibit the same in Court, making re-  
quest to have it allowed and approved of accordingly, if the said Jessiech Hanson

, above bounden, being thereto required, do render and deliver the said Letters of Administration, (approbation of such Testa-  
ment being first had and made in the said Court,) then this Obligation to be void; otherwise to  
remain in full force and virtue.
