severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our Seals, and dated this the *13* day of *January*, 186*5*.

The Condition of the above Obligation is Such, That if the above bounden

Administrator of all and singular the Goods and Chattels, Rights and Credits of

*Nancy Hinson*, deceased, do make or cause to be made, a true and perfect  
inventory of all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits of the deceased, which have  
or may come to the hands, knowledge or possession of the said *Jessiah Hinson*

or into the hands or possession of  
any person or persons for *him*, and the same so made, do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited  
in County Court, within the time prescribed by law, after the date of these presents; and the same  
goods, chattels and credits, and all other the goods, chattels and credits of the deceased, at the time  
of *her* death, or which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said

or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for \_\_\_\_\_ do well and truly  
administer according to law: And further, do make, or cause to be made, a true and just account
